NOW, THEREFORE, the Plan is hereby amended as follows, effective as provided therein:

The text of item C.2a.i is deleted in its entirety and the following is substituted therefore effective 01/01/2011:

Participant, spouse and dependents. The Participant, his or her spouse and all dependents within the meaning of Code section 152 as modified by Code section 105(b), and any child (as defined in section 152(f)(1)) of the taxpayer who as of the end of the taxable (calendar) year has not attained age 27.

Summary of Material Modifications

The purpose of this Summary of Material Modifications is to inform you of a change that has been made to the Maple Valley Fire & Life safety Health Reimbursement Arrangement. This change has affected the information previously provided to you in the Plan's Summary Plan description. The Summary Plan Description is modified as described below.

Health Reimbursement Account

When you become eligible to participate in the Plan, you will be entitled to receive reimbursement from this account for Eligible Expenses. Eligible Expenses now include expenses incurred by a child who is under the age of 27 through the end of the calendar year.
