The applicant agrees to comply with all permit terms and conditions of Maple Valley Fire & Life Safety and all Puget Sound Clean Air Agency rules and regulations. This permit allows the applicant to burn yard debris on their property and is issued subject to the following conditions:

1. Burn pile shall not exceed 10 ft. x 10 ft. x 6 ft. Piles shall be hand-stacked.
2. Multiple piles shall be separated 5 times the width of the pile. Only one pile may be burned at any time.
3. Burn pile shall be located at least 50 feet from any structure, fence, tree line or other combustible material.
4. **Only natural vegetation, yard debris from the property such as leaves and branches, shall be burned.** The fire shall not contain garbage, building materials, rubber products, plastics or petroleum products, cardboard or paper, or dead animals. **LAND-CLEARING FIRES ARE PROHIBITED.**
5. Burning shall occur only during daylight hours. Ensure that weather conditions are such that burning is safe.
6. The fire shall be constantly attended; a means of extinguishing the fire shall be readily available.
7. The fire shall not create too much smoke and be a nuisance.
8. Burn barrels are illegal and shall not be used.
9. Burn permit shall be located on site while burning.
