



RESOLUTION NO. R-2014-01

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS, MAPLE VALLEY FIRE & LIFE SAFETY, (King County Fire Protection District #43) WAVING THE ANNUAL AUTOMATIC 3% INCREASE IN AMBULANCE TRANSPORT FEES FOR THE YEAR 2014.

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to provide ambulance transport services within the jurisdiction by using fire department resources; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Fire Commissioners passed Resolution R-05-03 Authorizing Fire District Aid Cars to transport to area hospitals and bill the patient for the transport service; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Fire Commissioners believe it would be in the best interests of the citizens, residents, and visitors in this jurisdiction to have emergency medical transport services available, and to approve a schedule of reasonable rates and charges as approved by Resolution R-2006-02; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Fire Commissioners has determined the necessity to adopt the fee schedule, with rates fixed in accordance with this resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Fire Commissioners believes that the automatic 3% inflation increase is not necessary or warranted;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED: by the Board of Fire Commissioners of Maple Valley Fire & Life Safety that:

The 2014 rates for Basic Life Support transport provided by or on behalf of the Fire District, the rate per patient call is hereby approved and shall be the same as 2013; \$716.43 base rate, plus mileage at \$14.33 per mile and any costs levied against the District by other agencies or companies.
