A MOTION was made, seconded and unanimously carried to #12001 through #12034 for \$29,007.89 (General Fund); #12035 through #12041 for \$17,481.52 (Capital Fund); #12042 through #12060 for \$3,644.39 (General Fund) Payroll for \$161,347.58; Payroll Taxes for \$35,586.26 and Retirement for \$41,701.60.

The regular meeting adjourned at 8:10 pm to Executive Session for approximately 45 minutes.
