Tahoma School District Levy Support

**WHEREAS**, the Tahoma School Board has identified a need to replace two levies and fund a bus levy on February 13, 2018, and

**WHEREAS**, the Tahoma School Board has determined this funding is essential to the operation of the school district, and

**WHEREAS**, the replacement levies include technology and educational programs for operations that would be collected over four years, beginning in 2019, and

**WHEREAS**, the Tahoma School Board has also authorized a two-year levy to purchase buses that will enlarge the fleet and make it possible to retire older buses that were purchased in the 1990s.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** BY THE BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS OF MAPLE VALLEY FIRE & LIFE SAFETY (KING COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT #43) hereby expresses its support of Proposition No. 1 Replacement of Existing Educational Programs and Operations Levy, Proposition No. 2 Replacement of Existing Capital Projects Levies and Proposition No. 3 School Busy Levy.
